MOVE UPS

Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of the dog qualifying for an agility title. The request for moving up must be made to the Trial Secretary in writing not later than the Monday at 6:00 pm preceding the event. All move-up entries are subject to availability of the class and payment of any difference in entry fee. Refer to Chapter 1, Section 20 of the Regulations for Agility Trials for additional move-up requirements. Also refer to Chapter 1. Section 22 regarding entry corrections.

JUMP HEIGHT CARDS

Starting January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All height divisions will be offered in both the Standard and Jumpers with Weaves classes. Dogs in Preferred classes MUST jump their measured height and may not jump in a higher height or any qualifying scores or placements will be disallowed. Therefore, it you are unsure of your dog's correct jump height, please enter the lower height and if necessary, your dog will be moved to their higher height.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION and WARM UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the Judge's Briefing. The walkthrough is restricted to handlers entered in that class.

AKC no longer allows obstacle familiarization for Novice dogs.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors

REGULAR CLASSES

NOVICE AGILITY CLASS-The Novice agility class is divided into Division A for persons and dogs that have never acquired an AKC agility title, and Novice B for dogs who acquired the Novice Agility Title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility judges.

OPEN AGILITY CLASS-Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility or Open Agility Titles, but have not acquired the Agility Excellent Title.

EXCELLENT AGILITY CLASS Open to dogs that have acquired the Open Agility title, and to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title but that have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Agility Excellent title

MASTER AGILITY CLASS - Open only to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title, and to dogs that have acquired the Master Agility Excellent title

NOVICE JUMPERS WITH WEAVES-The Novice Jumpers with Weaves class is divided into division A for persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title from any organization, and division B for dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility judges.

OPEN JUMPERS WITH WEAVES-Open to all dogs that have acquired the Novice Jumpers with Weaves title, Novice Agility title or Open Agility titles but which have not acquired the Agility Excellent Jumpers with Weaves title.

EXCELLENT JUMPERS WITH WEAVES- Open to dogs that have acquired the Open Agility Jumper title and to dogs that have acquired the Excellent Agility Jumper title but have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master

MASTER JUMPERS WITH WEAVES - Open only to dogs that have acquired the Excellent Agility Jumper title and to dogs that have acquired a Master Excellent Jumper title.

PREFERRED CLASSES PREFERRED CLASSES

The Preferred Classes are open to any dog eligible to enter an agility trial as defined in Chapter 1, Section 3. The owner may choose to enter the Preferred Classes in lieu of entering the Regular Classes.

<u>Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day Effective January 1, 2020</u>, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial. TRIAL HOURS 7:00 a.m. to 30 minutes after last run; judging will commence no earlier than 8:00 a.m.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. **A charge of \$35.00** will be made for each returned check

TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as trial closes Acknowledgment of entries will include confirmation notices.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the match, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

TRIAL COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

DOGS PARTICIPATING- This trial is open to all Afghan Hounds over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Due to space limitations ONLY Dogs that are entered in the trial are permitted on show grounds.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

REFUNDS: There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. Refunds after closing date for bitches in season only. ALL REFUNDS MUST INCLUDE OWNER'S NAME AND MAILING ADDRESS WITH REQUEST AND WILL BE SUBJECT TO A \$10.00 PROCESSING FEE.

Written verification from a veterinarian is required. Notification for refund of bitches in season must be made before the start of the trial. A Veterinarian's note AND Final Trial Conformation for dog must accompany any such refund request.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not eligible to participate OR BE IN THE AGILITY ROOM BEFORE OR DURING COMPETITION. Entry fees will be refunded.

Fix and Go On (FNG) As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes <u>must</u> compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division <u>higher or lower</u> then their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
