Eligibility

Open to all afghan hounds at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, or afghan hounds with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. (An event is defined by an event number.)

Conditions of Entry

Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5-minute grace period. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused (with entry refunded). Spayed or neutered hounds may be entered.

You will be expected to have complete info on your dog for each entry.

Incomplete entries and those submitted by E-MAIL WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The gate to the Park is no longer locked.
- The pasture field has no amenities or shade available. Please ensure the comfort of you and your hounds by bringing your own portable shade/shelter and water.
- Permanent Restrooms available
- All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.
- Only purebred Afghan Hounds which are registered with the AKC or have an AKC ILP number may be entered.
- Each hound requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form.
- Hounds disqualified from AKC, ASFA or CKC Field Trials may be entered in the FastCAT.
- At time of inspection, bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused and their entry fee refunded.
- Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds may not be entered.
- Spayed or neutered hounds (without breed disqualifications) may be entered.
- Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched, and entry fees will not be refunded.
- Muzzles are not required; it is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hound should be muzzled.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club or its members and representatives.
- THE AFGHAN HOUND CLUB OF AMERICA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO TAKE CORRECTIVE ACTION against any individual(s) who engage in inappropriate conduct prejudicial to the interest of the sport of purebred dogs, or the Club, as determined by Club officials, and/or the Event Committee. Individuals who engage in disruptive or aggressive conduct at any event during the National Specialty will be subject to corrective action, including discipline and/or expulsion from the event. Should the Event Committee determine that expulsion is the appropriate course of action, refunds will not be given.
- The event-hosting club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators.
- ALL RIGHTS TO TELEVISION, VIDEO TAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Afghan Hound Club of America, Inc., or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the Show Grounds at any time while the show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, video tape, or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.
- A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose hounds not competing in the course in progress.
- A return check fee of \$35.00 will be assessed for any check(s) returned for insufficient funds.
- All hounds to be inspected for entry in the AKC FastCAT must be presented without tape, bandages, or wrapping on the toes, feet, or legs. Committee members may request that cold-weather coverings such as blankets, coats, and pajamas be removed from hounds under inspection.
- Ordering for FastCAT's will be at the discretion of the field committee, typically on an "is waiting and ready" basis. Priority for field committee dogs running will be given to free them up to work the Tests.
- Field Committee Members and Trial Volunteers may have their hounds inspected prior to the designated inspection time by the full inspection committee.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not allowed.

FastCAT Information

- **WHAT MUST MY DOG DO TO PASS A FastCAT?** - Fast CAT, unlike the CAT, is not a pass/fail, but a timed 100 yard dash after a lure through a start gate and a stop gate. The time is converted over to MPH and then multiplied by a potential handicap based on the dog's height to award points.
- **CAN MY DOG EARN AN AKC TITLE FOR FastCAT?** - Titles are earned by accumulating points. The following titles will be awarded: BCAT = 150 points; DCAT = 500 points; FCAT = 1,000 points; and FCAT followed by a number (e.g. FCAT2) for every additional 500 points. These suffix titles will appear on a dog's pedigree, with a higher level title superseding a lower level title.
- **WHAT ARE PRE-ENTRIES?** - Entries made before the closing date. If your entry is mailed in time yet due to the failure of the postal service it is not received in time for the Test Secretary to have it at the Event, then you will have to fill out day of entry forms on the day of the trial. Always have your dog's registration materials with you when you go to a test.
- **WHAT ARE "DAY OF" ENTRIES?** - Entries accepted after the closing date for pre-entries are considered Day of Entries. The deadline for Pre-entries is typically two days before the event. "Day of" entries are usually more expensive because the Field Test Secretary (FTS) must take extra time to add those entries to the record sheets the morning of the test, which delays the start of the trial. If you are entering on the day of the test, you MUST have your completed entry to the Test Secretary BEFORE Roll Call.
- **SLIP LEADS** - There is a type of collar for coursing called a slip lead, which is worn only to control the dog prior to release. The collar drops away as the dog is released to chase the lure and they run without anything around their necks that could be dangerous. SLIP LEADS WILL BE PROVIDED
- **INSPECTION** - Dogs will be inspected by a designated Inspection Committee consisting of at least two persons who are members of the Field Committee and who shall inspect each entered dog for lameness, fitness to compete and female estrus (in season). Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the Inspection Committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete or in season shall not be allowed to enter and the applicable entry fees shall be refunded.
- **ROLL CALL** - The time, prior to the commencement of coursing, by which you are supposed to have your dog ready for inspection by the Inspection Committee. At roll call the dog is examined for lameness, and breed disqualifications (where applicable). Unspayed bitches are examined to see if they show any evidence of being in season. After roll call the list of passed hounds is taken to the Field Test Secretary so that the run order can be prepared.
- **RUN ORDER LIST** - This is a posted list of the running order for the dogs participating in the event. Always check the record sheet after the Roll Call to confirm your dog's Run Order.

Field & Course Plans

- Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used.
- The lure will consist of plastic strips contrasting the terrain.
- The members of the AHCA reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.
- Please do not park on the grass.
- Start and finish light curtain system with scoreboard will be used for accurate timing.
- Orange safety fencing will be setup along the entire length of the track and catch area.
- Tests will be run concurrently. You may do back-to-back runs if you so choose.
