OBSTACLES

Obstacles will conform to the current requirements of the Agility Regulations. All jumps are displaceable. Weave Poles mandatory in all Standard and JWW Classes

MOVE UPS

Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of the dog qualifying for an agility title. The request for moving up must be made to the Trial Secretary in writing not later than Monday at 6:00 pm preceding the event. All move-up entries are subject to availability of the class and payment of any difference in entry fee. Refer to Chapter 1, Section 20 of the Regulations for Agility Trials for additional move-up requirements. Also refer to Chapter 1, Section 22 regarding entry corrections.

JUMP HEIGHT CARDS

Starting January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. All height divisions will be offered in both the Standard and Jumpers with Weaves classes. Dogs in Preferred classes MUST jump their measured height and may not jump in a higher height or any qualifying scores or placements will be disallowed. Therefore, if you are unsure of your dog's correct jump height, please enter the lower height and if necessary, your dog will be moved to their higher height.

24C -	Dogs may be entered at the 24" height at their owner's discretion if their measurement is 22 inches and under at the withers. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24- choice.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION and WARMUPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the Judge's Briefing. The walkthrough is restricted to handlers entered in that class.

AKC no longer allows obstacle familiarization for Novice dogs.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for all exhibitors

REGULAR CLASSES

NOVICE AGILITY CLASS- Division A is for persons and dogs that have never acquired an AKC agility title. Division B is for dogs who acquired the Novice Agility Title, and/or persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility judges.

OPEN AGILITY CLASS-Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility or Open Agility Titles but have not acquired the Agility Excellent Title.

EXCELLENT AGILITY CLASS-Division A is for dogs that have acquired the Open Agility Title but have not acquired a qualifying score in the Excellent B Class. Division B is for dogs that have acquired the AX title and for dogs that have acquired the MX title. Qualifying scores for the AX title are acquired in the Excellent A Class, and qualifying scores for the MX title and Master Agility Championship titles are acquired from the Excellent B Class.

MASTER AGILITY CLASS- Open only to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title, and to dogs that have acquired the Master Agility Excellent title

NOVICE JUMPERS WITH WEAVES-The Novice Jumpers with Weaves class is divided into division A for persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title from any organization, and division B for dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility title, persons that have handled a dog to an agility title, and for agility judges.

OPEN JUMPERS WITH WEAVES-Open to all dogs that have acquired the Novice Jumpers with Weaves title, Novice Agility title or Open Agility titles but which have not acquired the Agility Excellent Jumpers with Weaves title.

EXCELLENT JUMPERS WITH WEAVES-Division A is for dogs that have acquired the Open JWW Agility Title, but which have not acquired a qualifying score in the Excellent B Class. Division B is for dogs that have acquired the AXJ title and for dogs that have acquired the MXJ title. Qualifying scores for the AXJ title are acquired in the Excellent A Class, and qualifying scores for the MXJ title and Master Agility Championship titles are acquired from the Excellent B Class.

MASTER JUMPERS WITH WEAVES-. Open only to dogs that have acquired the Excellent Agility Jumper title and to dogs that have acquired a Master Excellent Jumper title.

PREFERRED CLASSES

The Preferred Classes are open to any dog eligible to enter an agility trial as defined in Chapter 1, Section 3. The owner may choose to enter the Preferred Classes in lieu of entering the Regular Classes. Owners are allowed to switch back and forth between Regular and Preferred Classes, but not at the same set of trials. Dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time must enter the Novice level in both Standard and JWW Class regardless of their previous title level in the Regular Classes. The same Regulations apply for divisions A and B as those described for the Regular titling classes (see above) (EXCEPT in Novice, where no A & B divisions exist). Dogs qualifying at this titling event receive credit toward their title. A recording fee is included with entry fees.

NO SMOKING ALLOWED INSIDE THE SHOW FACILITY.

TRIAL HOURS 7:00 a.m. to 30 minutes after last run; judging will commence no earlier than 8:00 a.m.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. **A charge of \$35.00** will be made for each returned check

ERRORS ON ENTRIES-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

REFUNDS: Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. Refunds after closing date for bitches in season only. All refunds must include owner's name and mailing address with request

THE CURRENT PRESIDENT, National Specialty Show Chairperson, Co-Show Chairperson and members of the Bench Show Committee, and members of their household, shall not exhibit, nor cause to be exhibited, dogs they own, or co-own, in competitive classes at this National Specialty Show. The Agility/Obedience/Rally/Triathlon Trial Secretary and/or Chairperson may exhibit, or cause to be exhibited, dogs they own, or co-own, in competitive classes at this National Specialty Show and affiliated events.

THE AFGHAN HOUND CLUB OF AMERICA RESERVES THE RIGHT TO TAKE CORRECTIVE ACTION against any individual(s) who engage in inappropriate conduct prejudicial to the interest of the sport of purebred dogs, or the Club, as determined by Club officials, and/or the Event Committee. Individuals who engage in disruptive or aggressive conduct at any event during the National Specialty will be subject to corrective action, including discipline and/or expulsion from the event. Should the Event Committee determine that expulsion is the appropriate course of action, refunds will not be given.

ALL RIGHTS TO TELEVISION, VIDEO TAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Afghan Hound Club of America, Inc., or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the Show Grounds at any time

while the show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, video tape, or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

TRIAL COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

DOGS PARTICIPATING- This trial is open to all Afghan Hounds over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP). Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Due to space limitations ONLY Dogs that are entered in the trial are permitted on show grounds.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not eligible to participate or be in the Agility Room before or during competition. Entry fees will be refunded. Written verification from a veterinarian is required. **Notification for refund of bitches in season must be made before the start of the trial. A Veterinarian's note AND Final Trial Confirmation for dog must accompany any such refund request.**

Fix and Go On (FNG) As outlined in AKC Agility Rules and Regulations, Chapter 5, Section 8, FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and preferred Classes Within the Same Trial – multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial

Effective January 1, 2020, Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes at the same trial. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both regular OR both Preferred in the same trial.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master ST/JWW, while also entered in 24-inch Premier STD/JWW in the same trial.

Determination of Agility HIT Determination will proceed from the most challenging upper-level classes to lower levels.

First order for determination

1. Double qualifying scores in REGULAR Ex./Master classes
2. Qualifying score in REGULAR Ex./Master classes

Second order for determination If no qualifier exists in the REGULAR Ex./Master classes, determination will proceed to the REGULAR Open classes according to the same ranking above.

Third order for determination If no qualifier exists in the REGULAR Ex./Master or Open classes, determination will proceed to the REGULAR Novice classes according to the same ranking above.

Fourth order for determination If no qualifier exists in the REGULAR classes, determination will proceed to PREFERRED classes according to the same ordering as REGULAR.

Tie Breaker If multiple qualifiers exist in a category above, scores will determine ranking in that category, followed by total seconds below SCT to break a tie.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
