Novice Intermediate Class: Boys And Girls Who Are At Least 12 Years And Under 15 Years Old On The Day Of The Show And Who, At The Time Entries Close, Have Not Won Three First Places, With Competition Present, In A Novice Class At A Licensed Or Member Show.

Novice Senior Class: Boys And Girls Who Are At Least 15 Years And Under 18 Years Old On The Day Of The Show And Who, At The Time Entries Close, Have Not Won Three First Places, With Competition Present, In A Novice Class At A Licensed Or Member Show.

Open Junior Class: Boys And Girls Who Are At Least 10 Years And Under 12 Years Old On The Day Of The Show And Who, At The Time Entries Close, Have Won Three First Places, With Competition Present, In A Novice Class At A Licensed Or Member Show.

Open Intermediate Class: Boys And Girls Who Are At Least 12 Years And Under 15 Years Old On The Day Of The Show And Who, At The Time Entries Close, Have Won Three First Places, With Competition Present, In A Novice Class At A Licensed Or Member Show.

Open Senior Class: Boys And Girls Who Are At Least 15 Years And Under 18 Years Old On The Day Of The Show And Who, At The Time Entries Close, Have Won Three First Places, With Competition Present, In A Novice Class At A Licensed Or Member Show.

Master Class: This Class Will Be For Boys And Girls Who Are At Least 9 Years Old And Under 18 Years On The Day Of The Show, And Who Have Won The 10 First Place Wins In An Open Class With Competition To Be Eligible To Enter The Limited Class Competition. The Calendar For This Class Will Be November 1-October 31 Of The Following Year. All Juniors Meeting The Criteria For This Class Are Required To Enter The Master Class And May Change Their Entry The Day Of The Show If Entries Have Already Closed.
